SUNDAY WORSHIP & PARADE INFO:

WORSHIP AT FIRST UMC: 180 Denny Way

First UMC is located at the corner of Denny Way and 2nd Ave. N, near the entrance to Seattle Center and at the end point for the parade (see map on reverse side). They will have a Pride-focused worship service at 10:00 AM. Those marching in the parade will be leaving the service at 10:30. Participants will be provided directions on how to walk or bus to our parade staging area (details below).

A NOTE ABOUT TIMING

The parade starts at 11:00 AM. Organizers are asking us to arrive between 11:00 and 11:30 AM. It's hard to estimate when we'll begin marching, but it's likely to be close to noon.

TRAVEL FROM FIRST UMC TO PARADE STAGING AREA


Option 1: BUS—D Line from First UMC to 3rd and Pike

An organizer will direct your walk from First UMC (180 Denny Way) to D/C Line Rapid Ride Bus. Note that METRO fare is <u>\$3.50</u> each way, and <u>exact change</u> is required if paying with cash. Buses will likely be crowded.

Option 2: WALK


An organizer will direct those wanting to walk from Seattle First UMC to our parade staging area on 4th Avenue between Union and University Streets. The distance is about 1 mile.



Where to find us on Pride Sunday—Staging location


The Parade starts at 4th & Union, proceeding Northwest along 4th Avenue past Westlake Park and on through Belltown to the corner of 4th & Denny Way (approx. 1.5 miles). The Parade is scheduled to start at 11:00 AM. The first entrant in the parade will be at 4th & Union, with higher numbers lining up behind along 4th Avenue. **Our contingent number for the parade is 3.03**. **Our staging location is in the 3rd block, on 4th Ave between University and Seneca Streets.** You'll be able to locate us by our "All Are Welcome" banner and round "Pride + Faith" signs (like the one shown above). It is recommended that you join us by 11:15 AM. It's <u>estimated</u> that we'll begin marching at 11:50 AM.





PrideFest At Seattle Center

Our booth at PrideFest is located on the roof of Fisher Pavilion, just north of the Children's Theater. The booth will be staffed from 10:00 AM until 4:00 PM. Stop by for a cookie or to help out!

Advice on what to wear and what to bring
